The theme, 'PLAN/ NON- PLAN', refers to a revolutionary and influential proposal by Cedric Price put forward in Architectural Design back in 1969 to revoke most of the then planning legislation. Currently, if the Government brings in the new National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) along the lines of its recent consultation document, Town Planning guidance, including environmental and historic conservation, amounting to some 5,000 pages of national policy, will be replaced by a single 50 page document. Many, including NGOs and Amenity Societies, see this as opening the door to planning mayhem. Others think it doesn't go far enough and challenge the fundamental value of development control, questioning why we need it at all.
